## Going to church on Halloween? That's right.

Did you know that Halloween derives from a holy day, All Saints' Day on November 1st? The root word of Halloween "hallow" means "holy" and the "een" is an abbreviation of "evening". The Eve of All Hallows is the night before All Saints Day. Since earliest times, Christians gathered on the Eve of All Hallows to declare God's blessing and protection from evil in the world. Often, they would dress in costumes of saints or evil spirits to mock evil and act out its defeat at the hands of Jesus Christ, declaring its lack of power over their lives. That's the source of the modern observance of Halloween.

Then, All Saints Day the next day would celebrate inspiring stories of heroes of the faith from the past and the present. Ordinary "saints" would also be honoured - the known and those known only to God.

This year, we are joining this tradition with a special ALL SAINTS SERVICE to remember those incredible people who've gone before us. It will be held on Halloween, Sunday October 31st.

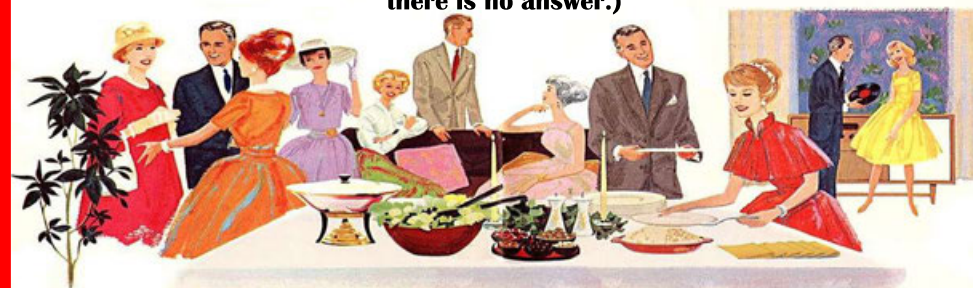

## APPLE CHUTNEY

- |                                    |   |
|------------------------------------|---|
| 7 lb (3.5 kg) Cooking apples       | 1 lb (500 g) sultanas                       |
| 2 – 3 garlic cloves                | 8 oz (250 g) crystalized ginger             |
| 2 pints vinegar                    | 1 tsp each of mixed spice, cayenne and salt |
| 3 lb (1.5 kg) brown or white sugar |   |



Simmer the peeled, finely chopped apples with the crushed garlic and quarter of the vinegar until soft.

Add the sugar, sultanas, ginger and spices and cook for a further 20 mins.

Stir in remaining vinegar and simmer till thick.

Pot in hot jars and seal.

## UDDER FARM NEWS

First of all, we would like to thank all of you who came and visited us for the Harvest Celebration and Harvest Lunch. Thanks to your support a total of £350.00 has been sent to the Farming Community Network, this was the proceeds of the lunch as well as some donations.

It was a year ago we started telling you what was happening on the udder side and at this time of year we are beginning to form our social bubble for the winter, at the moment us girls are staying in at night and being fed silage, as the grass had slowed down its growth rate. It also means they can get us in quicker in the morning as they know where we are and not hiding under a hedge out of the rain or wind. Our babies that have been born so far are all housed and by the beginning of November last years calves will be coming into the yards to join us, as we will be housed day and night by then, unless we get some really good weather and the grass keeps growing. (If it does you will need to keep cutting your lawns.)

So, by the end of the month, we will be in total lockdown until March/April, but at least we will be in the warm and dry and all our food will be put in front of us.

Last month we told you that one of the fields had been ploughed and reseeded with a new ley with a mixture of grass and clover for us to eat next year, it has germinated well and we look across at it waiting to taste the goodies in it next year, we have also *herd* that some of the silage fields have been over sown with some new grasses and clover to fix the nitrogen, to save applying so much inorganic fertilizer, which at the moment is over twice the price it was a year ago and is still rising due to lack of gas and the cost of it. If they only asked us, we are supposed to be capable of producing a lot of gas.

Thank you once again for coming to see us and sampling Wyke Farms cheese made with our milk and also the £350.00 donated to F.C.N.

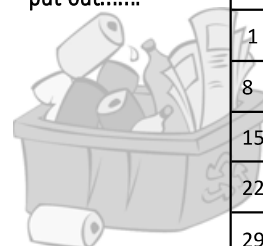
